Clinical II Duration 01 hour and 30 minutes

(a) **Oral Pathology** Duration 40 minutes

2 OSCE stations – 10 minutes each and 20 minutes discussion.

This component involves identification of basic histological features and relating them to the clinical situation and overall management of the patient.

Viva Component

Viva II - Maxillofacial Surgery and case book discussion Duration 45 minutes
