

Support for Sri Lankan Doctors/Trainees

We, as Luton and Dunstable Hospital Foundation Trust, will be supporting our Sri Lankan doctors/trainees with the following:

1. Before arriving in UK, the Trust will support doctors to attend English classes if needed in order to complete their IELTS examination.
2. The Trust agrees to reimburse candidates on commencement of employment through the monthly salary, fees to the maximum of three IELTS exams. We will also reimburse maximum of two courses of English classes.
3. The Trust will also fund a total of £1750 for each and every doctor towards their visa fee, Royal College of Physicians registration fee and GMC registration fee.
4. When arriving in Luton, the Trust will help doctors to find accommodation in the hospital or local area and will pay for the first month of their rent, up to a maximum of £1000.
5. During their working period in the Trust, doctors will be provided with a £1,500 per year for relevant external conferences, courses and towards MRCP examination fees. They are allocated appropriate number of study leave during this time. They will also receive regular support and mentoring from an allocated Educational Supervisor (a consultant at the Trust).
6. Salary level of the doctors will be determined on experience from their time of Graduation in Sri Lanka at the UK equivalent level on commencement of employment.
7. Appointed doctors will also have a named contact at the Luton and Dunstable Hospital for any queries or concerns that they may have. The named person will be the pastoral care for the doctors on before and after arrival.
