POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN ANATOMY EXAMINATION

(MODULES 3, 11) - NOVEMBER 2017

1. The above modules examination will commence on **18th November 2017**
2. Applications are invited by me up to 06th November 2017 from medical /dental officers possessing the following eligibility requirements to sit the above Modules, i.e. Statistics and Integrated Human Anatomy.

A minimum of 80% attendance at each of the components – lectures, tutorials and practicals.

Note: A candidate who fails to obtain 80% attendance without a valid reason should complete the requirement and sit the next available examination.

3. The prescribed fees for the examination shall be as follow:-

(a) Application fee	- Rs. 2,000/=
(b) Registration fee	- Rs. 5,000/=
(a) Examination fee	- Rs. 13,500/=

(Only online payments through the PGIM online portal will be accepted by the PGIM)

4. The application form can be downloaded from the website <http://pgim.cmb.ac.lk/on> payment of Rs. 2000/-.
5. The **Statistics Module** examination will consist of a Four (04) Structured Essay Questions of one hour duration and the **Integrated Human Anatomy Module** examination will consist of Ten (10) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs), Two (02) Structured Essay Questions (SEQs) and Twenty (20) Objectively Structured Practical Examination (OSPE).
6. Applications with **every cage duly filled** should be forwarded through the Head of Department. The applications should reach the Assistant Registrar/ Examinations, PGIM. No. 160, Professor Nandadasa Kodagoda Mw, Colombo 7 **on or before 06th November 2017**. The envelope should be marked "Application for Postgraduate Diploma in Anatomy (Module 3 & 11) Examination" at the top left hand corner **incomplete applications and late applications will not be considered under any circumstances.**

The candidates will be issued an **“Examination Feedback Form”** with the admission documents and this should be sent back to Director /PGIM under confidential cover **within 48 hours after conclusion of the examination.** If the form is not returned it will be assumed that you do not have any concerns regarding the examination and it was conducted according to the Prospectus/rules/regulations of the PGIM. **No complaints or concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following release of results** nor will these be investigated by the PGIM.
