SECTION I EXAMINATION
(FOUNDATION, HAEMATOLOGY, CARDIOVASCULAR
AND RESPIRATORY MODULES)

1. The above Section I examination will commence on **07th January, 2017**.
2. Applications are invited by me up to **20th December, 2016** from medical officers/ non –medical officers possessing the following requirements to sit the above examination.

Eligibility to sit the module examination –

- I. A minimum of 80% attendance for lectures, tutorials, small group discussions, practical classes and other teaching components of each module.
- II. Successful completion of assignments for each module.
- III. Adherence to the PGIM rules and regulations in relation to examinations.

Note: A Candidate, who fails to obtain 80% attendance without a valid reason or failed to complete the assignment successfully, should complete these requirements before deadline of application to sit the examination.

3. The prescribed fees for the examination shall be as follow:-

(a) Application fee	- Rs. 2000/=
(b) Registration fee	- Rs. 5000/=
(a) Examination fee	- Rs. 13,500/=

4. The above examination will consist of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs), Structured Essay Questions (SEQs), and Objectively Structured Practical Examination (OSPE) components.
5. Requirements to pass the Postgraduate Diploma in Medical Physiology Section I Examination Grade C or above for all Module Examinations and GPA 2.0 or more.
6. Further details and the prescribed application forms from the Examinations Branch, Postgraduate Institute of Medicine on payment of Rs. 1000/-.The application form also could be downloaded from our website www.pgim.cmb.ac.lk on payment of Rs. 1000/-.The envelope should be marked **“Application for Postgraduate Diploma in Medical Physiology –Section I”** at the top left hand corner.

7. Applications with every **case duly filled** should be forwarded through the Head of Department, confirming that the applicant if selected would be released for postgraduate training in the PGIM. The applications should reach the Senior Assistant Registrar/Examinations, PGIM, 160, Norris Canal Road, Colombo 7, on or before **20th December, 2016. Incomplete applications and late applications will not be considered under any circumstances.**
8. Please bring the contents of the Circular Letter to the notice of all medical officers concerned in your department/division/faculty.
9. The results will be valid and official after confirmation by the Senate of the University.
10. The candidates will be issued an **“Examination Feedback Form”** with the admission documents and this should be sent back to Director/PGIM under confidential cover **within 48 hours after conclusion of the examination.** If the form is not returned it will be assumed that you do not have any concerns regarding the examination and it was conducted according to the Prospectus/rules/regulations of the PGIM. **No complaints or concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following the release of results** nor will these be investigated by the PGIM.
