## MSc in CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY AND THERAPEUTICS EXAMINATION – FEBRUARY 2020

- 1. The above examination will commence on Thursday, 27th February 2020
  - End of course examination Thursday, 27th February 2020
  - Dissertation viva Friday 06th March 2020
- 2. Applications are invited from MSc in Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics trainees who have satisfied the following criteria:
  - 1) Satisfactory attendance (>80% in lectures and discussions)
  - 2) Satisfactory completion of the specified number of assignments and presentations
  - 3) Handed over the completed casebook 3 months before the End of Course Examination and obtain a minimum of 50% of marks in the viva based on case book.
  - 4) Hand over the completed research dissertation 3 months before the End of Course Examination.
- 3. The MSc in Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics examination consists of three components,
  - Continuous Assessments (CA)
  - End of Course Examination (Paper I & Paper II)
  - Research Dissertation
- 4. To pass the MSc in Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics Examination, a candidate should obtain a mark of 40% or above for each component and an average overall mark of 50% or above.
- 5. Please note that candidates are allowed only 6 attempts at the MD examination which must be completed within a period of 8 years from the date of first examination. However, after failing the fifth attempt the candidates should undergo a minimum period of one year further training before permitted the sixth attempt.
- 6. The prescribed fees for the examination shall be, as follows:
  - (a) Registration fee

- Rs. 6,000.00 (Non refundable)

(b) Examination fees

- Rs. 34,500.00

(c) Assessment fee of dissertation

- Rs. 6,000.00 (Non refundable)

(d) Application Fee

-Rs. 2,500.00 (Non refundable)

(Candidates from non-state sector will be charged 50% more of the above listed fees)

- 7. The application form can be downloaded from the <a href="www.pgim.cmb.ac.lk">www.pgim.cmb.ac.lk</a>
- 8. The applications with every cage duly filled should be forwarded to the Assistant Registrar/Examinations, PGIM, 160, Prof Nandadasa Kodagoda Mawatha, Colombo 7 on or before 20th January 2020, through the Head of Department/Course Coordinator. Late applications will not be considered under any circumstances. The envelope should be marked "Application for MSc in Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics Examination February 2020" at the top left-hand corner.
- 9. The results will be valid after confirmation by the Senate of the University
- 10. The candidates will be issued an "Examination Feedback Form" with the admission documents. Feedback in Part II should be limited to concerns; if any, regarding the conduct of the examination (eg. perceived biases, discriminatory behavior, harassment, intimidation) and NOT regarding the format or content of the examination. The form should be sent back to Director/PGIM under confidential cover within 48 hours after conclusion of the examination. No concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following the release of results, nor will these be investigated by the PGIM.
