### POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN MOLECULAR MEDICINE EXAMINATION II (MODULE 03 & 04) – JANUARY 2019

The above examination will commence on **14<sup>th</sup> January 2019**.

1. Application are invited by me up to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018 from medical officers / Non-medical officers possessing the following requirements to sit the above examination.  
A minimum of 80% attendance at each of the components – lectures, tutorials and practicals.  
A Candidate who fails to obtain 80% attendance without a valid reason should complete the requirement and sit the next available examination.
2. Examination II will consist of Structured Essay Question Papers – SEQ (Theory) and Objectively Structured Practical Examination (OSPE) components.
3. In order to pass the examination a candidate should obtain a minimum of 50% for the theory component (SEQ) and 40% for the laboratory components and obtain at least a C grade to pass a module.
4. The prescribed fees for the examination shall be as follow: -

6. The results will be valid and official after confirmation by the Senate of the University.
7. The candidates will be issued an “**Examination Feedback Form**” with the admission documents. Feedback in Part II should be limited to concerns, if any, regarding the conduct of the examination (e.g. perceived biases, discriminatory behavior, harassment, intimidation) and NOT regarding the format or content of the examination. The form should be sent back to Director/PGIM under confidential cover **within 48 hours after conclusion of the examination. No concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following the release of results** nor will these be investigated by the PGIM.
8. Completed applications with every cage duly filled should be reach the Asst. Registrar/ Examinations, Postgraduate Institute of Medicine, 160, Professor Nandadasa Kodagoda Mawatha, Colombo 07 on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018. The envelope should be marked “Application for Postgraduate Diploma in Molecular Medicine (Module 03 & 04) Examination II – January 2019” at the top left-hand corner. Incomplete applications and late applications will not be considered under any circumstances.
