**SELECTION EXAMINATION FOR ENROLMENT TO THE IN-SERVICE  
TRAINING PROGRAMME IN RADIOLOGY-SEPTEMBER 2018**

1. The above examination is scheduled to commence on **14<sup>th</sup> September 2018**.
2. Applications are invited by me from medical officers in the state and non-state sectors possessing the following requirements to sit the Selection Examination for enrolment to the in-service training programme in Radiology.
  - (a) A medical degree registered with the Sri Lanka Medical Council;
  - (b) Satisfactory completion of internship acceptable to the Sri Lanka Medical Council;
  - (c) Satisfactory completion of one year of post internship in medical practice in a University/Public Sector Institution /Private sector (see item 6 in General Regulations and Guidelines 2018) ) in Sri Lanka acceptable to the PGIM as at the date of closure of applications, ie. **31<sup>st</sup> August 2018**.

**Note :-**

The criteria prescribed in paragraph (c) must have been satisfied by the applicants as at the date of closure of applications provided that where a short-fall has occurred due to any reasons including sick, maternity or other leave, the doctor concerned should complete such shortfall in order to become eligible to apply for the Selection Examinations.

3. The applicants to be eligible for enrolment to the training programme should pass the selection examination. The format of the selection examination for the perusal of applicant is described in the prospectus and examination documents which are available at the PGIM.
4. The selection examination shall consist of a Multiple-Choice Question Paper (40 questions) to be answered in two hours.
5. The candidates who pass the selection examination by obtaining 50% or more marks for the MCQ only shall be considered for enrollment to the course.
