

Carrying over the marks of the Research Projects at the MD in Medical Administration Part II Examination

Addendum made to the 'Requirements to pass the MD Part II Examination' in the Prospectus for MD Medical Administration 2011, replacing the previous addendum approved by the Senate at its meeting held on 30.01.2018, to be effective retrospectively from September 2017.

The marks of the research project/s can be carried over until the permissible attempts are over or the candidate passes the examination, whichever is earlier, when

- a) a candidate has obtained 50% or more of the total aggregate and passed the Research Project/s (Part C)) but failed in the Written examination (Part A) and/or Oral examination (Part B)
OR
- b) a candidate has not obtained 50% or more of the total aggregate but passed the Written examination (Part A), Oral examination (Part B) and Research Project/s (Part C)
OR
- c) a candidate has not obtained 50% or more of the total aggregate and failed in the Written examination (Part A) and/or Oral examination (Part B) but passed the Research Project/s (Part C))

Further, if a candidate has failed in **either** Part A or Part B, even with a total aggregate of 50%, such a candidate has to sit for **both Parts A and B** at the next attempt.
