- 1. The above Section III examination will commence **on 25th July, 2020.**
- 2. Applications are invited by me from medical officers/ non –medical officers registered for the Postgraduate Diploma in Medical Physiology and possessing the following requirements to sit the above examination.
 - (a) A minimum of 80% attendance at each of the components lectures, tutorials, small group discussions, practical classes and other teaching components of each module.
 - (b) Successful completion of assignments on each module.

Note:

A Candidate, who fails to obtain 80% attendance without a valid reason or failed to complete the assignment successfully, should complete these requirements before the deadline of application to sit the examination.

- 3. The above examination will consist of Multiple-Choice Question (MCQ) Paper, Structured Essay Question (SEQ) Paper, and Objectively Structured Practical Examination (OSPE) components.
- 4. Requirements to pass the Postgraduate Diploma in Medical Physiology Examination is Grade C or above for all Module Examinations and GPA 2.0 or more.
- 5. The prescribed fees for the examination shall be as follow: -

(a) Application fee	- Rs.	2,500/=
(b) Registration fee	- Rs.	6,000/=
(a) Examination fee	- Rs.	16,000/=

Only Online Payment through the PGIM online portal will be accepted.

- 7. Applications with every cage duly filled should reach the Senior Assistant Registrar/Examinations, PGIM, 160, Prof. Nandadasa Kodagoda Mawatha, Colombo 7, on or before 12th July 2020. The envelope as should be marked "Application for Postgraduate Diploma in Medical Physiology –Section III Examination" at the top left-hand corner. Incomplete applications and late applications will not be considered under any circumstances.
- 8. Please bring the contents of the Circular Letter to the notice of all medical officers concerned.
- 9. The results will be valid and official after confirmation by the Senate of the University.
- 10. The candidates will be issued an "<u>Examination Feedback Form</u>" with the admission documents and this should be sent back to Director/PGIM under confidential cover <u>within 48 hours after</u> <u>conclusion of the examination</u>. If the form is not returned it will be assumed that you do not have any concerns regarding the examination, and it was conducted according to the Prospectus/rules/regulations of the PGIM. No complaints or concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following the release of results nor will these be investigated by the PGIM.
