# POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL PHYSIOLOGY SECTION I, II, & III (REPEAT) EXAMINATION

### FEBRUARY 2021

- 1. The above Section I, II, and III examinations will commence on **20**<sup>th</sup> **February 2021.**
- 2. Applications are invited by me from medical officers/ non -medical officers possessing the following requirements to sit the above examination.
  - (a) A minimum of 80% attendance at each of the components lectures, tutorials, small group discussions, practical classes and other teaching components of each module.
  - (b) Successful completion of assignments on each module.

#### Note:

A Candidate, who fails to obtain 80% attendance without a valid reason or failed to complete the assignment successfully, should complete these requirements before the deadline of application to sit the examination.

- 3. The above examination will consist of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) Paper, Structured Essay Questions (SEQ) Paper, and Objectively Structured Practical Examination (OSPE) components.
- 4. Requirements to pass the Postgraduate Diploma in Medical Physiology Examination is Grade C or above for all Module Examinations and GPA 2.0 or more.
- 5. The prescribed fees for the examination shall be as follow:-

(a) Application fee - Rs. 3,500/= (b) Registration fee - Rs. 8,000/= (a) Examination fee - Rs. 20,000/=

### Only online payments through the PGIM online portal will be accepted.

6. The application form also could be downloaded from our website www.pgim.cmb.ac.lk.

- 7. Duly filled application should be forwarded through the Head of the Department confirming that the applicant if selected would be released for the Postgraduate training in the PGIM. All the candidates should send the scan copy of your application after obtaining all the signatures of relevant authorities to <a href="mailto:exam@pgim.cmb.ac.lk">exam@pgim.cmb.ac.lk</a> and applicants are recommended to send the hard copy of the application to the Assistant Registrar/Examinations, Postgraduate Institute of Medicine, 160, Professor Nandadasa Kodagoda Mawatha, Colombo 07 on or before 10th February 2021. If you are unable to send the hard copy of the application, please mention the fact in the same email. Incomplete, handwritten and late applications will not be considered under any circumstances
- 8. Please bring the contents of the Circular Letter to the notice of all medical officers concerned in your department/division/faculty.
- 9. The results will be valid and official after confirmation by the Senate of the University.
- 10. The candidates will be issued an "<u>Examination Feedback Form</u>" with the admission documents and this should be sent back to Director/PGIM under confidential cover <u>within 48 hours after conclusion of the examination</u>. If the form is not returned it will be assumed that you do not have any concerns regarding the examination and it was conducted according to the Prospectus/rules/regulations of the PGIM. No complaints or concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following the release of results nor will these be investigated by the PGIM.
- 11. A trainee following a PG Certificate or PG Diploma or MSc or MD programme shall not be permitted to sit another selection examination for a PG Certificate or PG Diploma or MSc or MD. If the trainee leaves the course before completion of a programme/course of study, he/she shall not be permitted to sit for another selection examination for a minimum period of two years from the date of leaving the programme/course of study. This rule shall not apply for online and part time courses.
