**MSc IN BIOMEDICAL INFORMATICS (SEMESTER I) BATCH 11 EXAMINATION-
MARCH 2021**

1. The above Examination commences on **19th March 2021**.
2. Applications are invited by me up to **03rd March 2021** from medical officers/ non – medical officers possessing the following requirements to sit the above examination.
 - Demonstrate at least 80% attendance for lecture sessions and laboratory work during the semester for which the assessment is held.
3. The Examination shall consist of following components.
 - a) Assignments - For M2 & M3
 - b) Theory Paper- For M1, M4 & M5
4. A candidate should obtain a minimum of Grade C (equivalent to a grade point of 2.0) for each module Assignment / Theory Paper to pass a module.
5. The prescribed fees for the examination for candidates in the state sector as follows:-

(a) Application fee	- Rs.	3,500/= (Non Refundable)
(b) Registration fee	- Rs.	8,000/= (Non Refundable)
(c) Examination fees	- Rs.	20,000/= (Non Refundable)

(Only online payments through the PGIM online portal will be accepted by the PGIM)

(Candidates from non-state sector will be charged 50% more of the above listed fees)
6. The application form can be downloaded from the website <http://pgim.cmb.ac.lk>.

7. Duly filled application should be forwarded through the Head of the Department confirming that the applicant if selected would be released for the Postgraduate training in the PGIM. **All the candidates should send the scan copy of your application after obtaining all the signatures of relevant authorities to exam@pgim.cmb.ac.lk** and applicants are recommended to send the hard copy of the application to the Assistant Registrar/Examinations, Postgraduate Institute of Medicine, 160, Professor Nandadasa Kodagoda Mawatha, Colombo 07 **on or before 03rd March 2021. If you are unable to send the hard copy of the application, please mention the fact in the same email. Incomplete, handwritten, and late applications will not be considered under any circumstances**
8. Please refer to the new regulations laid down by Ministry of Health regarding release of Medical Officers of Department of Health website – <http://www.health.gov.lk/en/>
9. The candidates will be issued an “**Examination Feedback Form**” with the admission documents. Feedback in Part II should be limited to concerns, if any, regarding the conduct of the examination (eg. perceived biases, discriminatory behaviour, harassment, intimidation) and **NOT** regarding the format or content of the examination. The form should be sent back to Director/PGIM under confidential cover **within 48 hours after conclusion of the examination. No concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following the release of results** nor will these be investigated by the PGIM.
