FEBRUARY 2022

1. The above examination is scheduled to commence on **07th February 2022**.
2. Applications are invited by me up to **13th January 2022** from medical officers/ non –medical officers possessing the following requirements to sit the above examination:-
 - Demonstrate at least 80% attendance for lecture sessions and laboratory work during the semester for which the assessment is held.
3. The Examination shall consist of following components.
 - a) Assignments - For M7 & M10
 - b) Theory Paper- For M6,M8 & M9
4. A candidate should obtain a minimum of Grade C (equivalent to a grade point of 2.0 or above) for each module Assignment / Theory Paper to pass a module.
5. The prescribed fees for the examination for candidates in the state sector as follows:-

(a) Application fee	- Rs.	3,500/= (Non-Refundable)
(b) Registration fee	- Rs.	8,000/= (Non-Refundable)
(c) Examination fees	- Rs.	20,000/= (Non-Refundable)

(Only online payments through the PGIM online portal will be acceptable)

(Candidates from non-state sector will be charged 50% more of the above listed fees)

6. The application form can be downloaded from the website www.pgim.cmb.ac.lk.

7. All examination Applications and other documents are collected through a Google Form. <https://forms.gle/pHuCqHiwX2GU2bN56> on or before **13th January 2022**. All applicants should have a Gmail Account to log in to a google form. PGIM trainees have to use the email account created by the PGIM. You should attach your exam application with all the relevant documents as **a single PDF** document since this portal does not allow you to attach multiple documents. **Please note that incomplete, handwritten, late submission and application sent via email will not be accepted.**
8. Please refer to the new regulations laid down by Ministry of Health regarding release of Medical Officers of Department of Health website – <http://www.health.gov.lk/en/>
9. The results will be valid and official after confirmation by the Senate of the University
10. The candidates will be issued an **“Examination Feedback Form”** with the admission documents. Feedback in Part II should be limited to concerns, if any, regarding the conduct of the examination (eg. perceived biases, discriminatory behaviour, harassment, intimidation) and **NOT** regarding the format or content of the examination. The form should be sent back to Director/PGIM under confidential cover **within 48 hours after conclusion of the examination. No concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following the release of results** nor will these be investigated by the PGIM.
