Facilities offered at different categories of Medical Care Institutions-2020

Reference is made to the General Circular Letter No. 02-61/2005 dated 11th May 2005 on hospital recategorization. According to the said circular, hospitals have been categorized as Teaching Hospitals, Provincial General Hospitals, District General Hospitals, District Base Hospitals, Divisional Hospitals and Primary Medical Care Units. The specialist services that should be made available under different categories of hospitals has also been identified in that circular.

Since then, the disease burden and health needs in the country have changed considerably due to changes in the demographic profile and life style. To cater to this need, several new specialties and sub-specialties have been introduced to the postgraduate training in Sri Lanka. Hence, the services that should be provided under different categories of hospitals have been revised and therefore the said circular is hereby replaced.

Revised services by category of hospital are given in Annex I and the list of hospitals with the relevant category is given in Annex II. Please prepare your future hospital development plans in accordance to the attached revised services stipulated in Annex I.

Facilities offered at different categories of Medical Care Institutions - 2020

1. Introduction

In Sri Lanka, the curative healthcare delivery is primarily carried out by the Government Hospitals. These hospitals are graded as Teaching Hospitals, Provincial General Hospitals, District General Hospitals, Base Hospitals A & B, Divisional Hospitals and Primary Medical Care Units. Consultant led care is made available down to the level of Base Hospitals and in some instances to Divisional Hospitals where Consultant Family Physicians are placed.

At present, all Medical Specialties are approved as Medical Specialists by the Department of Management Services. The Ministry of Healthcare & Indigenous Medical Services has developed a norm for the required cadre by specialty for Base Hospitals and above.

The general circular No. 02-61/2005 on hospital re-categorization, dated 11th May, 2005 indicates the number of specialized units that should be available in Teaching Hospitals, Provincial General Hospitals, District General Hospitals and Base Hospitals. Since then, the disease burden and health needs in the country have changed considerably due to changes in the demographic profile and life style. To cater to this demand, several new specialties and sub-specialties have been introduced to the postgraduate training in Sri Lanka. Many doctors have been successfully trained locally as well as overseas as consultants to deliver the services required by the population. The specialists in these new specialties and sub-specialties have to be placed at the correct levels of healthcare institutions in order to optimize their services. Thus, it is important to update the facilities that should be offered at different categories of health institutions in Sri Lanka. Determining cadre required from each specialty for each category of hospital would enable the provision of infrastructure and training of the required number of doctors to fill those vacancies. This would result in the proper distribution of specialist services throughout the country.

The Essential Services Package (ESP) has been identified as a tool to achieve Universal Health Coverage and the ESP specifies the services that should be made available at different categories of hospitals. Further, a list of posts of Medical Specialists were approved by the Cabinet of Ministers on 10th February, 2010 for the Cabinet Memorandum No. 10/0317/360/009. The revisions to the circular have been made taking into consideration the list of specialties approved by the Cabinet of Ministers and the ESP.

2. The Objective

To make amendments to the general circular No. 02-61/2005, dated 11th May, 2005 on facilities to be offered at different types of hospitals

3. The Process

- The hospital re-categorization circular No. 02-61/2005, dated 11th May 2005 which indicates the facilities offered at different categories of medical care institutions and the number of specialized units that should be available in Teaching Hospitals, Provincial General Hospitals, District General Hospitals and Base Hospitals was scrutinised.
- Organization and Development Unit identified the specialties that should be available in Base Hospitals and above following consultative meetings with relevant Colleges.

- The specialties and sub specialties for which the Post Graduate Institute of Medicine (PGIM) awards postgraduate qualifications were obtained from the PGIM website.
- The number of medical specialists in position hospital-wise was obtained from Deputy Director General (Medical Services I).
- The essential services that should be provided by each type of hospital was obtained from the ESP.
- A series of consultative meetings was conducted with officials of the Ministry of Health to discuss the facilities that should be available at different categories of medical care institutions.
- Following the discussions, the type of facilities that should be made available, including the specialized services down to the grade of Base Hospitals were decided and concluded as stated below.

4. The Outcome

The general circular No. 02-61/2005, dated 11th May, 2005 was amended as follows.

5. Facilities offered at different categories of Medical Care Institutions

Minimum facilities recommended to be made available at different levels of curative medical institutions in order to maintain equity are given in Annex I. However, additional facilities may be provided depending on specific needs.

Facilities offered at National Hospitals

The following criteria have to be fulfilled for designating a health institution as a National Hospital.

1. Administration, Ownership or Control

- The hospital should be owned and administered by Central government via the Ministry of Health

2. Size of the hospital:

- Based on bed capacity and bed occupancy
 - o The hospital should have a minimum in-patient bed number of 2500
 - o Number of specialized units – more than 50
 - o Number of ICU beds over 100

3. Based on functionality

- Type of care:
 - o The hospital should function as a tertiary referral center for primary and secondary healthcare institutions
 - o The hospital should provide referral services in highly specialized areas to other specialties and/or to other tertiary-level hospitals
 - o The hospital should be the final referral institution (An apex centre of care)
 - o A & E with consultants rostered round the clock
 - o Round the clock functioning of any surgical and medical emergencies, emergency interventions interventional radiological procedures, emergency cardiology interventional procedures including stenting
 - o Should have an adverse event reporting system and fixing the system based on the root cause analysis

4. By teaching affiliation:

- The hospital should provide teaching/training facilities to medical/dental and allied health (nursing/dental/pharmacy/physiotherapy etc.) education at undergraduate and postgraduate levels.
- The hospital should provide clinical audit, multidisciplinary team meetings, research and publication and CME programmes

5. Based on hospital statistics

- OPD attendance – over 350,000
- Annual admissions (Including ETU) – over 200,000
- Clinic attendance – over 1 million
- Bed turnover over 90%

6. Based on number of employee (permanent/casual)

- Over 5000 (Medical, nursing, allied and supportive or other)

7. Based on annual expenditure

- Should be over Rs 10 billion per annum

8. Based advanced technology

- All types of radiological interventions including MRI, CT, CAT, Cath lab, Pacemaker lab, Intervention radiology, Fluoroscopy, Mammography that are available in the public sector
- Advanced biochemistry lab, Advanced microbiology lab, Advanced Haematology lab, Advanced histopathology and virology lab excluding those that require specialized laboratories

9. Based on availability of modern / advanced medical and surgical care

- Such as multiorgan transplant program
- Revision arthroplasty in Orthopaedic surgery etc.

10. Based on the use of advanced IT for patient care

- Established digitalization program
- All ambulatory care services (OPD, and clinics) should have programmed waiting times
