POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL PHYSIOLOGY SECTION III (SPECIAL) EXAMINATION

<u>NEUROPHYSIOLOGY I & NEUROPHYSIOLOGY II MODULES)</u> JULY 2023

- 1. The above Section III examination will commence on **28th July 2023.**
- 2. Applications are invited by me from medical officers/ non –medical officers possessing the following requirements to sit the above examination.
 - (a) A minimum of 80% attendance at each of the components lectures, tutorials, small group discussions, practical classes and other teaching components of each module.
 - (b) Successful completion of assignments on each module.
- 3. The above examination will consist of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) Paper, Structured Essay Questions (SEQ) Paper, and Objectively Structured Practical Examination (OSPE) components.
- 4. Requirements to pass the Postgraduate Diploma in Medical Physiology Examination is Grade C or above for all Module Examinations and GPA 2.0 or more.
- 5. The prescribed fees for the examination shall be as follow:-

(a) Application fee	- Rs.	5,500/=
(b) Registration fee	- Rs.	12,500/=
(a) Examination fee	- Rs.	31,000/=

Only online payment through the PGIM online portal will be accepted by the PGIM

(Candidates from non-state sector will be charged 50% more of the above listed fees)

- 6. Please note that a candidate must complete the Diploma within six (06) attempts in not more than 8 years from the date of passing the selection examination.
- 7. The application form also could be downloaded from our website <u>www.pgim.cmb.ac.lk</u>.

- 8. All examination applications and other documents will be collected through a Google form https://forms.gle/oEqjRsQu8sWU37K6A on or before 20th July 2023. Candidates have to use the email accounts created by the PGIM to access the Google form. The exam application with all relevant documents must be attached as a single pdf document since this portal does not allow uploading of multiple documents. Please note that incomplete, handwritten, late submission and application sent via email will not be accepted.
- 9. Please refer the new regulations laid down by Ministry of Health regarding release of Medical Officers of Department of Health in MOH website <u>www.health.gov.lk</u>.
- 10. Each year only the scheduled examination in the approved examination calendar shall be held. No repeat or additional examinations will be held.
- 11. The results will be valid and official after confirmation by the Senate of the University.
- 12. The candidates will be issued an "Examination Feedback Form" with the admission documents. Feedback in Part II should be limited to concerns, if any, regarding the conduct of the examination (eg. perceived biases, discriminatory behaviour, harassment, intimidation) and <u>NOT</u> regarding the format or content of the examination. The form should be sent back to the Director/PGIM under confidential cover within 48 hours after conclusion of the examination. No concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following the release of results nor will these be investigated by the PGIM. The results will be valid and official after confirmation by the Senate of the University.
