MD (COMMUNITY DENTISTRY) THEORY EXAMINATION – MAY 2024 (2015 PROSPECTUS)

- 01. The above examination will commence on 20th May 2024.
- **02.** The examination shall consist of Two components.
 - A. Two Theory Papers
 - B. Structured Oral Examination (SOE)

A. Theory papers

The two theory papers will consist of four (04) questions in each paper with a duration of two (02) hours per paper.

B. Structured oral examination (SOE)

There will be two viva boards, each of 20 minutes duration.

- 03. In order to pass the examination a candidate should obtain an overall aggregate of 50% or more with a minimum mark of 50% for each theory paper and an average of 50% for the SOE. Those who fail the examination will be allowed to follow the training programme but will have to pass this component before the submission of the thesis.
- O4. The allocation of Pre and Post MD training units will be done as described in "General Regulations and Guidelines -2024 which is available on the PGIM web site http://pgim.cmb.ac.lk. The allocated training units shall not be changed for personal reasons.

05. The prescribed fees for the examination, shall be as follows:-

(a) Registration fee - Rs. 14,000.00 (Non-refundable)

(b) Examination fees - Rs. 74,500.00

(c) Application Fee - Rs. 7,500.00 (Non-refundable)

(Candidates from non-state sector will be charged 50% more of the above listed fees)

Note that only payments made through PGIM online portal will be accepted.

- **08.** Each year only the scheduled examination in the approved examination calendar will be held. **No repeat or additional examinations will be held**.
- O9. The candidates will be issued an "Examination Feedback Form" with the admission documents. Feedback in Part II should be limited to concerns; if any, regarding the conduct of the examination (e.g. . perceived biases, discriminatory behavior, harassment, intimidation) and NOT regarding the format or content of the examination. The form should be sent back to Director/PGIM under confidential cover within 48 hours after conclusion of the examination. No concerns regarding the examination will be entertained after 48 hours of conclusion of the examination or following the release of results, nor will these be investigated by the PGIM.
